DIVER MEDICAL CHECK-UP PROCEDURE

1 - PURPOSE

This procedure requires that the commercial divers must follow the laws and regulations in effect.

2- RESPONSIBILITY

The application of this procedure is under the responsibility of Operations Manager.

3- PROCEDURES

- 3.1 All commercial divers are sent to medical check-up every other year by the Harbour Master Subject check-ups shall be conducted by Underwater physicaian in an Underwater seasickness treatment facility with a decompression chamber. The first two year period starts with the certification date and sucseeding check-ups are conducted every two year.
- 3.2 As a result of check-up if commercial diver's health conditions does not permit for diving his/her certification must be marked as DIVING PROHIBITED and such mark shall be entered his/her records. In such cases their rights are protected to perform as a divemaster or to teach classes on land as an Instructor.
- 3.3 A comercial diver could reverse this procedure after treated or healed. In order to lift the prohibition he/she must provide a full medical exam and check-up by an Underwater physicaian in an Underwater seasickness treatment facility with a decompression chamber. After such report the prohibition is lifted and their records corrected accordingly.
